Palomar College Police Academy is an Extended Format, part-time academy that is completed in Modules. The training is conducted on nights and weekends, which allows a recruit to maintain employment while transitioning toward a law enforcement career.

Each Module provides the required training for the different levels of Reserve Peace Officers in California. Upon completion of all three Modules, a graduate would be eligible to be hired as a full-time sworn Peace Officer in California.

Financial Aid and Veterans benefits may be applied toward some academy costs.



APPLY TO AN AGENCY:

Candidates compete against 200+ other applicants for a limited amount of Entry Level positions.

Those hired at the entry level are hired by an agency first, then sent to an academy as an employee of a law enforcement agency.

They must successfully complete a police academy before entering a field training program.

ATTEND A POLICE ACADEMY:

Candidates first complete a police academy by putting themselves through training as a "self sponsored" or "open enrollee" recruit.

They then apply as an Academy Graduate applicant; agencies have more positions to hire those who have already completed academy training.

When hired by a department, these applicants immediately start a Field Training Program.

Go to school – College education is highly desirable by many agencies and required by some

Get involved – Explorer Posts, community groups, volunteering, community service oriented employment, civilian employment within an agency, etc.

Learn to be self-sufficient – Find answers and solutions without help.

Gain life experience – This brings with it many of the desired character traits agencies seek.
