This 40-hour course meets the POST requirements of PC 832 Arrest. Subject matter includes Criminal Law, Laws of Arrest, Search & Seizure, Use of Force, and Arrest and Control Techniques. Training includes classroom lecture and activities, as well as manipulative skills for Arrest and Control. Training will be eight (8) hours per day for five (5) days, and **attendance is mandatory**. Attendees must be free from injury and must successfully complete all course testing to pass the course. (40 hours total)
