Statement of Solidarity in Support of the Palomar College Transgender & LGBTQ Immigrant Community in Response to the Presidential Executive Orders Targeting Trans People and LGBTQ Immigrant People

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS:

Do not invite the police into your space – you are not required to open the door unless there is a valid warrant. You can talk with the officers through the door and ask them to show you identification and a warrant.

Ask the officer to slip the warrant under the door or hold it up to the window so you can read it. Officers can only search the areas and for the items listed.

Even if officers have a warrant, you have the right to remain silent. You should not answer questions or speak to the officers while they are in your house conducting the search.

You are entitled to legal representation in criminal proceedings.
