

# Graduating Senior & Palomar Promise Program

## To Do List:

1. Complete or update your Palomar College application for **FALL 2024**.
2. Locate your Palomar student ID number.
3. Create your Palomar College password.
4. **Apply for the Palomar Promise.**
5. **Apply for the 2024-2025 FAFSA or Dream Act** – Palomar College School Code: 001260.
6. Activate your Palomar College student email & check once a week for important information.
7. **K12: If you will not be 18 years old before AUGUST 26, 2024**, you must submit a K12 Special Admission form to Palomar's Admissions Department at [admissions@palomar.edu](mailto:admissions@palomar.edu) or at one of our education centers. For questions, contact Admissions at [admissions@palomar.edu](mailto:admissions@palomar.edu) (760) 744-1150 ext. 2164.
  - a. You do not need the high school to sign the form, as you will not be in high school for FALL 2024.
8. **Once you complete the Palomar Promise application:**
  - a. If you do not see a green check mark in your **RESIDENCY box**, contact Admissions at [admissions@palomar.edu](mailto:admissions@palomar.edu) or (760) 744-1150 ext. 2164.
  - b. If you do not see a green check mark in your **FAFSA/Dream Act box** and it's been several weeks since you filed your FAFSA or Dream Act, contact our Financial Aid Department at [finaid@palomar.edu](mailto:finaid@palomar.edu) or (760) 744-1150 ext. 2366.
9. Note: **Registration for FALL 2024 will begin MAY 6, 2024**
10. **FALL 2024 classes will begin AUGUST 26, 2024.**

**PASSWORD REQUIREMENTS**

Be at least eight (8) characters in length.  
Be no more than fifteen (15) characters in length  
Cannot exceed two (2) consecutive characters of the user's account ID/name  
Cannot re-use old passwords.  
Must contain characters from three (3) of the following four (4) categories:

- \* Uppercase characters (A-Z)
- \* Lowercase characters (a-z)
- \* Numeric characters (0-9)
- \* Special characters (! @ \$ % ^ \* ( ) - \_ = + \ | [ ] { } ; : / ? . >)

# What is the Palomar Promise & How to Apply:

## What is Palomar Promise & Requirements:

Palomar Promise offers up to **two** years of free tuition (*fall & spring*), textbook assistance, and access to specialized academic and career planning with related support services – **regardless of your family's income!**

## Requirements:

- Must file the 2024-2025 FASA or Dream Act – DO NOT NEED TO QUALIFY for financial aid.
- Be a California resident or from an eligible exempt group (i.e., AB 540 or military dependent)
- Must enroll in at least 12 units each semester (possible DRC exemptions)
- Maintain a 2.0 GPA

## How to Apply:

1. Login to MyPalomar Student Login
2. Click on Financials and then Palomar Promise.
3. If you see a message that you are not eligible, contact Promise and advise them to clear you, as you are a graduating high school senior.
4. Complete the application and submit it.
5. Your Promise Checklist will appear along with your current Promise application status. Keep an eye on it to make sure your CA residency is check marked and your FAFSA/Dream Act get a check mark after you file your FAFSA or Dream Act.
6. Check your Palomar student email frequently for information regarding your Promise application status and important updates/deadlines.
