What is Palomar Promise:

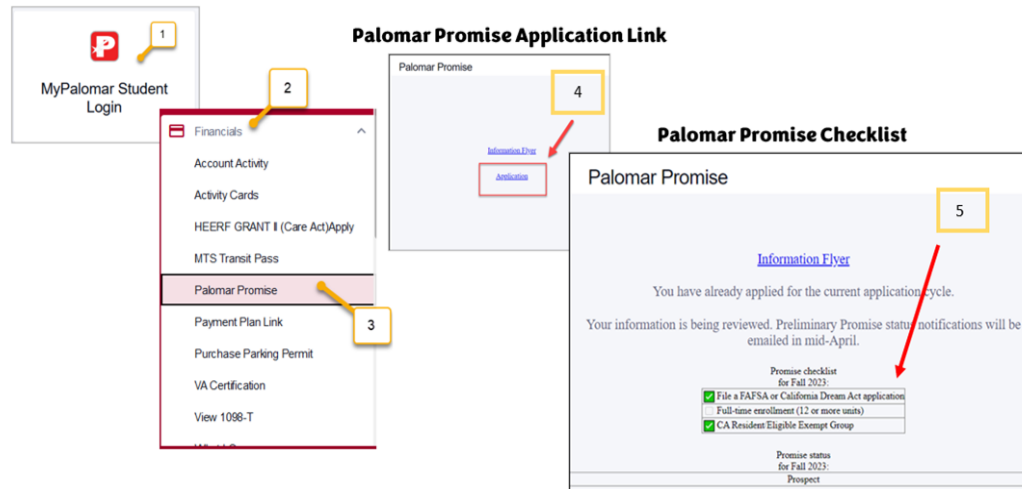
Promise offers up to two years of free tuition (fall & spring), textbook assistance, and specialized academic, career planning, and support services –

Regardless of family's income!

Requirements:

- File 2025-2026 FAFSA or Dream Act – **DO NOT NEED TO QUALIFY!**
- California resident or eligible exempt group (AB540 or military)
- 12 units each semester (possible DRC exemptions)
- 2.0 GPA

- **If message: Not eligible, for First Time College students, contact Promise to clear you. You are a graduating high school senior and took classes while in high school.**
- **Application:** 4 mouse clicks

 - ✓ Make sure **CA residency** is checked.
 - ✓ **FAFSA/Dream Act** gets a check several weeks after you file your FAFSA or Dream Act.

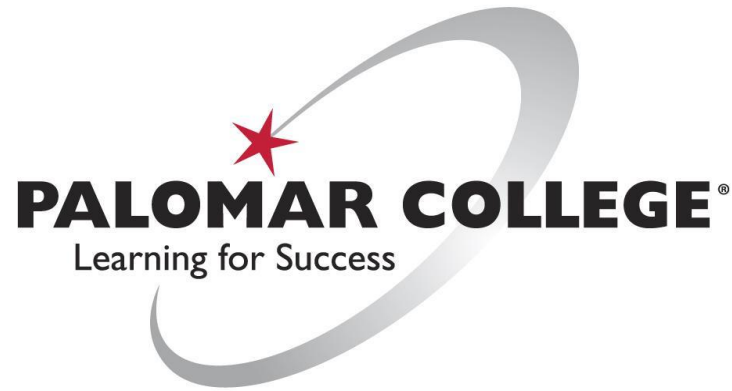

- Palomar annual **Scholarship season** May 5, 2025 – August 15, 2025.



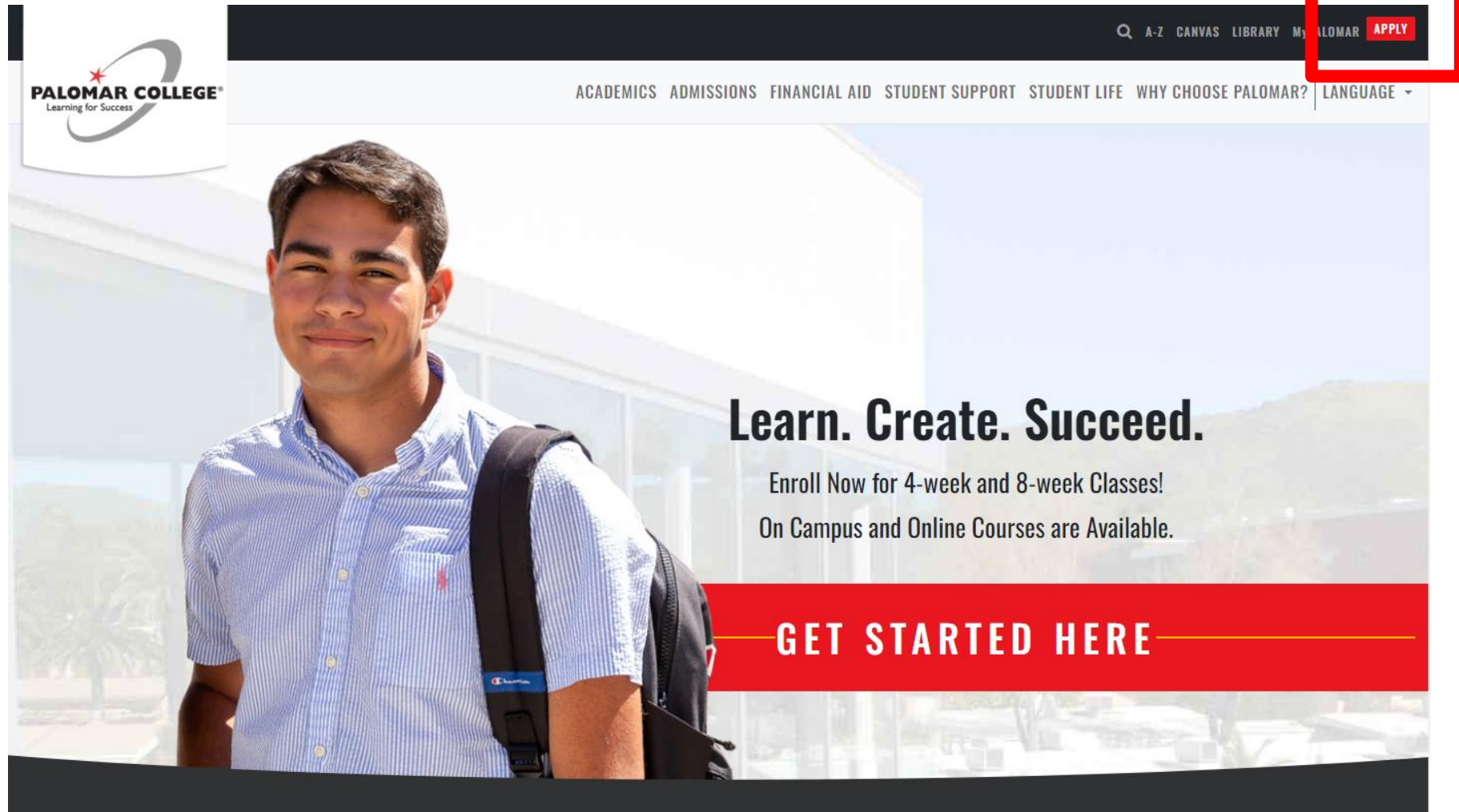
