Registration Error Messages

If you received an error message when trying to register, the information below may be used to help identify your particular situation.

EXAMPLE 1 – Satisfactory or Pending Grade

Error Message: Course was previously passed with a satisfactory grade, or Error Message: You have previously taken this course. When graded this course may be subject to repeat rules. Verify that the class will apply toward your course of study

What's wrong?	You are attempting to register for a class in which you have already received, or have
	pending, one of the following grades: A, B, C, P, CR, I.
Reason	New restrictions on course repeatability are in effect.
What to do	Select another course that is not on your academic transcript.

EXAMPLE 2 – Course with Related Content

Error Message: Course related in content limit exceeded.

What's	You are attempting to register for a course in a group of courses defined as "related in content" past
wrong?	the number of attempts allowed for the group.
Reason	Cluster of courses grouped together as having related content have a group limit of 4 enrollment attempts. Per your academic transcript, another enrollment in the course group will exceed the 4 attempt limit. Past enrollments to all members of the course group are counted.
What	You may not enroll in any of the courses in the affected group.
to do	Revise your class selection to avoid courses that are part of the group.

More information:

- Course groupings due to related content appear in the following disciplines: ART, ARTD, ARTI, DNCE, ENTT, KINE, MUS, TA.

- No matter the number of courses contained within a group, only four attempts are allowed within the group.
- Past enrollment attempts count toward the enrollment limits.
- Most courses successfully completed cannot be repeated (A, B, C, P, CR)*.
- All enrollments resulting in the following grades: A, B, C, D, F, FW, P, CR, NP, NC, W or I count as an attempt.
- Courses within a group may be repeated to forgive a substandard grade or because of withdrawal, but each enrollment attempt counts toward the group enrollment limit of four**.

*Some exceptions are available within DNCE and MUS groups where a course may be repeated – consult a counselor for more information.

** Enrollment attempts include: completions, incompletions, and withdrawals resulting in a grade of W or FW.

Courses within a related content group are limited to one enrollment for each satisfactory grade, with a maximum of four total enrollments within the group.

EXAMPLE 3 – Repeatable Courses*

Error Message: Repeat limit exceeded.

Note: Repeating a course may impact your financial aid eligibility or veterans' educational benefits.**

What's	You are attempting to register for a repeatable class past the number of attempts allowed.
wrong?	
Reason	Per your academic transcript, you have reached the number of attempts allowed for the course.
	Even repeatable courses have set limits that when exceeded will block enrollment.
What	Select another course that is not on your academic transcript
to do

EXAMPLE 4 – Withdrawals

Error Message: "W" grade limit exceeded.

What's	You are attempting to register for a course in which you have withdrawn 3 times.						
wrong?							
Reason	Per your academic transcript, you have withdrawn from the selected course three times. Academic						
	policy allows for three withdrawals from a course. A fourth attempt to complete the course is only						
	allowed by approved petition; the final attempt must result in a completion and a grade.						
What	 Select another course that is not on your academic transcript. 						
to do	2) Petition for a fourth attempt.

EXAMPLE 5 – Cooperative Work Experience*

Error Message: Unit limit exceeded for the course group - Enrollment not allowed

What's	You are attempting to register for a cooperative work experience course that will exceed unit
wrong?	limitations.
Reason	Per your academic transcript, either:
	1) You will exceed 16 total units of Cooperative Work Experience, or
	2) You will exceed 8 units of Cooperative Work experience for the semester.
What	Revise you class selections to remain under the unit limitations associated with Cooperative Work
to do	Experience.

EXAMPLE 6 – Repeat by petition: significant lapse of time You want to take a course again because it has been a long time since you last received formal instruction in the curriculum

Error Message: Course was previously passed with a satisfactory grade

What's	You are attempting to register for a class in which you have already received a passing grade (A, B,
wrong?	C, P, CR)
Reason	New restrictions on course repeatability are in effect.
What	One additional enrollment following a passing grade may be allowed by petition for only the
to do	following situation:
	 Significant lapse of time, defined as no less than 3 years since the grade was obtained, and 1) The district has established a recency prerequisite (e.g. Nursing, Dental Assisting, Emergency Medical Education), or 2) Another institution of higher education to which a student seeks to transfer has established a recency requirement.
	Note: Allow time for the review process to take place.

Grade Adjustment Examples (Significant Lapse of Time)

<u>One</u> additional enrollment may be granted on an appeal basis due to Significant Lapse of Time (must have received satisfactory grade)

EXAMPLE 7 – Repeat by petition: extenuating circumstances

You want to retake a course.

Error Message: Various error messages may apply. Enrollment is blocked.

What's wrong?	You have previously passed the course or another attempt will exceed enrollment limits.
Reason	New restrictions on course repeatability are in effect. Per your academic transcript, you have previously passed the course or another attempt will exceed enrollment limits for the course. Most courses may only be repeated one time due to documented extenuating circumstances.
What to do	One additional enrollment may be allowed by petition for extenuating circumstances.
	 Extenuating circumstances must be documented, and include only the following reasons: Accident, Illness, or Other circumstance that necessitated an extended absence from class. Note: Allow time for the review process to take place.

EXAMPLE 8 – Academic Renewal.

Error Message: Academic Renewal has been previously applied to this course. Enrollment is not allowed.

What's wrong?	You are attempting to register in a course for which Academic Renewal has been applied.
Reason	Per your academic transcript, Academic Renewal has been petitioned for and applied to this course previously. Once Academic Renewal has been applied to a course, that course may not be taken again within the Palomar College District for academic credit.
What to do	Select another course that has not had Academic Renewal applied.
