STRATEGIC PLANNING COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES April 1, 2008

The regular meeting of the Palomar College Strategic Planning Council was held on Tuesday, April 1, 2008, in SU-18. The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. by Robert Deegan.

D. DISCUSSION/INFORMATION ITEMS

1. Joint SPC/Budget Committee Meeting

Robert Deegan stated that he and Bonnie Ann Dowd are proposing a joint SPC/Budget Committee meeting for April 15, 2008, in place of the regular SPC meeting scheduled for that day. At the joint meeting they will discuss the 2007-2008 budget and the 2008-2009 budget. Discussion ensued. Everyone agreed to have a joint meeting on April 15. If there is an SPC item that must be approved for first and second reading prior to the summer break, it can be included on the agenda.

E. REPORTS OF PLANNING COUNCILS

1. Administrative Services Planning Council

Bonnie Dowd reported that ASPC met on March 20. Members continued to work on its Governance Structure Group Request form. ASPC is beginning development of the institutional review process for its division. ASPC has moved its meeting schedule to the first and third Thursday of each month from 2:00-3:30 p.m.

2. Human Resource Services Planning Council

John Tortarolo reported that HRSPC met on March 18. Members discussed the first reading of the grant application process; distributed the third draft version of the Equal Opportunity Plan; and listened to the standard reports from Staff Development, Budget, EEO, SPC, and Team Life committees.

3. <u>Instructional Planning Council</u>

Berta Cuaron reported that IPC met on March 12. Institutional review was primarily discussed. IPC committee members will review five of the plans for common themes, needs, and issues. The documents are available on the Research and Planning website. The IPC faculty hiring subcommittee are meeting to develop a priority list, which will be brought to IPC and then to SPC.

4. Student Services Planning Council

Joe Madrigal reported that SSPC did not meet last week because of spring break.

F. ACCREDITATION SELF-STUDY

Berta Cuaron reported that she reviewed with the co-chairs and staff assistant the first draft of each of the standards from the writing teams and have given them direct feedback. They are asking the writing teams to come back with revisions by April 11, to include information gleaned from the employee survey. The goal is to bring the second draft to the steering committee and the planning councils by the end of April. They are still looking for volunteers; it is not too late to jump on board.

G. **BUDGET COMMITTEE**

Bonnie Dowd reported that the Budget Committee did not meet last week because of spring break.

H. REPORTS OF CONSTITUENCIES

1. Administrative Association

Laura Gropen reported that the AA will have a general membership meeting on April 10, 2008. Their retreat is scheduled for the last Friday of May.

2. Associated Student Government

Jesse Lyn reported that a Region 10 meeting was held during spring break. They are preparing for the SSCCC spring conference on May 2-4. One of their new ASG members wants to run for an at-large position at the state level. At the Region 10 meeting, they voted as a region to have a mission statement and a region logo. They are also looking at a possible resolution on textbooks, asking for academic help with regard to textbook usage.

Ms. Lyn announced that when she began as president, ASG had only five members. They now have 12 members and hope to fill the remaining four openings before the end of the semester.

Sherry Titus announced that Jesse Lyn was named to the 2008 All State Academic Team for California. Only 77 people out of 2.6 million were chosen.

3. CAST

Lee Hoffmann announced that he was elected President of CAST and will be attending SPC as their representative.

4. CCE - no report

5. Faculty Senate

Brent Gowen reported that Faculty Senate is having ongoing discussions about accreditation, negotiations, and academic technology. When Kelly Hudson-MacIsaac and Tom Plotts came to the Senate to describe the status of the District's disaster emergency preparedness, the Senate recommended that the top of the priorities should be improved lighting, two-way communications, and a campus-wide PA system. Dr. Gowen spoke to Sherry Titus regarding the need for the Senate to proceed on an academic dishonesty procedure to complement the student grade dispute procedure.

6. <u>PFF</u>

Shannon Lienhart announced that Julie Ivey accepted a full-time position at Cerritos College working for the union as the executive director. PFF ballots were recently mailed for the two co-presidents and some e-board members. A negotiations meeting is scheduled for tomorrow afternoon. The CFT convention in Oakland is coming up April 11. The major focus of the convention will be to discuss how CFT can work with state legislation to advocate for fewer cuts at the state level towards community colleges.

I. PENDING ITEMS

Progress of the development of the smoking policy and procedures was discussed. ASG will bring the policy and procedures to SPC at the next meeting for a first reading. It will then go to the Policy and Procedures Task Force, then to the Governing Board for approval.

J. ADJOURNMENT

There being no remaining items, the meeting was adjourned at 3:30 p.m.
