#### Meeting called to order at 9:00 AM

#### A. Opening

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m. President Blake welcomed everyone to the joint Strategic Planning Council and Student Success and Equity Council Workshop meeting.

#### B. Integrated Planning

1. Integrated Planning

Michelle Barton welcomed everyone and asked each person to introduce themselves and share the impact they made on students.

Ms. Barton led a discussion on the definition of the following terms: mission, values, goals, objectives, strategies-initiatives, and key performance indicators. The key performance indicators for the District's Mission and Values were reviewed. A member felt the Mission and Vision does not reflect the student population we have now. Ms. Barton responded it is important to review these and to ensure equity is represented in all our plans.

The District's Vision Learning for Success was reviewed. Members shared what comes to mind when they think of the statement. Ms. Barton asked members to consider if the District's Mission and Values are the values we feel should guide our work. Most agreed and suggestions were made: include empowerment, a supportive environment, and define the word "equity" better.

Progress on the five Strategic Plan 2019 Goals was reviewed. Ms. Barton distributed a document showing the progress made on each goal and asked members to look at the list and let her know if they want to add something. She led a discussion on work that was done in Goals 2.4, 2.5, and 2.6.

The VfS, SP 2019, SEM, GP and Equity Plan goals were reviewed side-by-side. She stated many of the goals could be aligned across all the plans; though the wording may be different, the meaning is the same. The common denominator in all the plans is institutional accountability. Ms. Barton led a discussion on what an over-arching framework would look like: equity would be in all the plans; needs to be integrated to be institutional, and reflect our institutional priorities. Everyone agreed the SEM plan is transitional and can be integrated into the existing Strategic Plan. Some themes, such as mental health and disabilities are in the Equity Plan and could be added as an objective in the Strategic Plan, i.e., a student's basic needs will be reflected.

There was discussion on using existing resources to implement the changes. Ms. Barton reported the Chancellor's Office will be submitted a comprehensive plan which will include guidelines on how to link finances to the plan.

Strategic Plan 2022 Framework was discussed. The current SP 2019 goals can be revised and updated:

- Student outreach, persistence and completion (get on path/stay on path)
- · Teaching and learning (clarify the path, ensure learning)
- · Messaging and community engagement
- · Equity and diversity
- · Fiscal stewardship

The key performance indicators could be the VfS goal statements or the District could say what we will do to address Vfs in each plan. Under each goal statement the top priorities for the year from EMP, SEM, GP and Equity Plan could be aligned. The Staffing Plan and Technology Plan serve as support plans. Ms. Barton gave examples of how SP 2022 could be written. For instance, take the top three priorities from the GP, EMP, SEM, and Vfs.

### 2. Vision for Success and Equity Goal Setting

Ms. Barton led a discussion on the initial look at Vision for Success goals.
