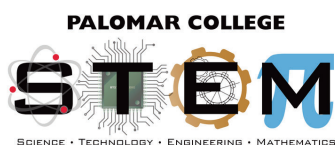
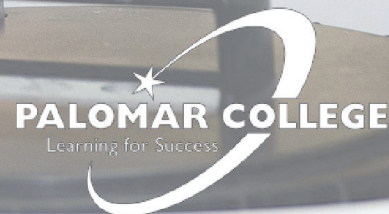
# BRIDGES TO THE FUTURE PROGRAM
