Steps to Enroll Checklist – Fall 2022

Step 1: Apply and Activate

- Apply online at www.palomar.edu/apply
 - Create an Open CCC Account or sign in if you already applied. Then complete a new Palomar Application.
 - Select: **Fall 2022** Term
 - HS Seniors complete the application as if you have already graduated-*{This will ensure the Promise Application link appears in your student center}*
 - Select: First-Time College Student
 - Select: Received a Diploma
 - Enter your future graduation date.
 - Returning students be sure to provide Palomar ID in the last step-*{To avoid Admissions hold}*
 - **Write down** the email used to create Open CCC, password, and CCCID for future reference. 
 - First time applicants will receive a Palomar ID number within 3 days after you submit the application.
- Retrieve Palomar ID** number from MyPalomar “ID/Password Help” or from email sent by Palomar. Create a password. **Write down** your Palomar ID, hint response, password, and email. Safeguard this information.
- Sign into MyPalomar at <https://my.palomar.edu> and click the Student Center Tab for the following:
 - You may be asked to fill out the Placement, Pathway and Credit for Prior Learning survey. English, math and reading placement will be displayed at the bottom of your Student Center.
 - Apply for Palomar Promise. Check the Palomar Promise website for application help, benefits, or next steps.
- Activate your Palomar student email** in MyPalomar. All official communication goes to this email. Check frequently.
- If you will not be 18 years old by the first day of the Fall semester, complete a [K12 Form](#);TLC collect parent signatures and submit to admissions@palomar.edu.

Step 2: Apply for Financial Aid | Palomar School Code: 001260

- File your 2022-2023 [FAFSA](#) or [CA Dream Act](#).
- Use your parent/guardian’s 2020 taxes. Check your financial aid [To Do List](#) in MyPalomar “Student Center.” Submit required information ASAP.

Step 3: Launch Your Success

- Review the Vaccination Policies.
- Complete the Connect for Success web form in [Canvas](#).
- Complete the New Student Orientation listed under the [To Do List](#) in MyPalomar “Student Center.”

Step 4: Review your Placement and Develop an Education Plan

- Login to MyPalomar to review your placement.

Step 5: Register and Pay for Classes
