Application Workshop – Fall 2023

Step 1: Apply and Activate

- Apply online at www.palomar.edu/apply
 - Create an Open CCC Account or sign in if you already applied.
 - Start a new Palomar Application
 - Returning students: Provide Palomar ID in the last step
 - Select: **Fall 2023** Term
 - High School Seniors Complete the application as if you have already graduated.
 - Select: First-Time College Student
 - Select: Received A Diploma
 - Enter your future graduation date
 - **Write down** the email used to create the OpenCCC Account for future reference.
 - First time applicant will receive a Palomar ID number within 3 days after application submission.
- Retrieve Palomar ID** number from MyPalomar “ID/Password Help” or from email sent by Palomar. Create a password. **Write down** your Palomar ID, hint response, password, and email. Safeguard this information.
- Sign into MyPalomar at <https://my.palomar.edu> and click the Student Center Tab for the following:
 - You may be asked to fill out the Placement, Pathway and Credit for Prior Learning survey. English, math and reading placement will be displayed at the bottom of your Student Center.
 - Apply for Palomar Promise. Check the [Palomar Promise website](#) for application help, benefits, or next steps.
- Activate your Palomar student email** in MyPalomar. All official communication goes to this email. Check frequently.
- If you will not be 18 years old by the first day of the Fall semester, complete a [K12 Form](#) and submit to admissions@palomar.edu.

Step 2: Apply for Financial Aid and Scholarships | Palomar School Code: 001260

- File your 2023-2024 [FAFSA](#) or [CA Dream Act](#).
- Use your parent/guardian’s 2021 taxes.
- Check your Financial Aid [To Do List](#) in MyPalomar and Submit required information ASAP.

Step 3: Launch Your Success

- Complete the New Student Orientation listed under the [To Do List](#) in MyPalomar.

Step 4: Review your Placement and Develop an Education Plan

- Login to MyPalomar to review your placement.

Step 5: Register and Pay for Classes
