What is Cal Fresh?

CalFresh is a nutrition assistance program that helps income-eligible households including individuals who are currently employed, unemployed, or retired to buy the food they need to stay healthy.



Anyone who is a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States can apply as long as income guidelines are met.



Benefits are given on EBT cards (similar to ATM cards) and can be used at most grocery stores.

Qualifications for Student Applicants

- * Work at least 20 hours per week on average
- * Be approved for Work-Study
- * Be a recipient of Cal Grant A or B
- * Be enrolled in a qualifying program including: WIOA, EOP, EOPS, CARE, Guardian Scholar, AB 12 Extended Foster Care, UC McNair, MESA, etc.

WHATYOUNEEDTO APPLY:

- * Proof of rent (rent receipt, lease contract, etc.)
- * Proof of identification (driver's license, passport, etc.)
- * Social Security number

- * Proof of income (pay stub, etc.)
- * Student aid information and school registration
- * Proof of participation in a specific student program (if applicable)
