In addition, the Food & Nutrition Center is taking the following proactive and voluntary steps to help reduce contact and/or spread of COVID-19:

- Providing gloves to all staff handling food in our Food & Nutrition Center and distribution sites
- Ensuring that staff and visitors are maintaining the recommended physical distance of 6' or more
- Increasing the visibility and importance of hand washing in our facility
- Recommending people avoid touching their eyes, nose, mouth with unwashed hands
- Recommending people avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Recommending staff to stay home from work, school or others if they display signs of illness or come into contact with affected individuals.
