 - a. Motion was approved unanimously.

- 5. New Business: Discussion/Action
 - i. Environmental Day: Monday, April 24th , 11:00 am 3:00 pm
 - a. **Chair Rodriguez:** There's only one ICC meeting before this date. Clubs are welcome. Reconvene with your clubs on whether you will join or participate on this date. It can be an opportunity for you to get recruitment for new students, especially if you weren't at club rush.
 - b. Advisor Rocca: Ask at your club meetings because it is early right now, and Advisor Amaris will get on this upon her return.
 - ii. Planning events as ICC
 - a. **Chair Rodriguez**: Clubs can get in touch with each other, too, to plan their own events and request it as an agenda item. Email me if you need each other's contact information.
 - iii. Rules Committee Requests
 - a. Chair Rodriguez: I suggest clubs reach out to me if you want to see something in the ASG bylaws, regarding ICC policy and procedure, be changed or removed. The Inter-Club Council is controlled by the bylaws which ASG has, and I can bring things to the ASG Rules Committee if ICC wants something modified. Article VIII in the bylaws is for the ICC.
 - b. Advisor Rocca: Chair wants to advocate for club points. ASG Bylaws are rules that ASG members have to follow, as does ICC. You can request changes to

them. This item should be tabled (to next meeting), and clubs can see they' re found under Article XIII, Section 7, III, i.

- c. Women and Gender Studies: What are the points for?
- d. **Chair Rodriguez**: Points are earned through contributions at the events. The more you show up, the more points and then money you get. They are not necessary to take action. If you want to get a discussion going, it can be easy for me to advocate for change with rules regarding clubs, if you all (clubs) want to.
- e. Advisor Rocca: I gave account balances to you all if you want to start spending money. You have to put the spending money request as an agenda item format, even if your club has informal meetings with no agendas. You can check the step-by-step process under the Palomar website's "Student Organization Expenses and Reimbursements" section.
 - i. Go to the club with a formal agenda item to use the money.
 - ii. It's a re-imbursement process with proper steps and documents required in order to confirm the reimbursement.

- i. ICC Club Reports (2 min. max)
 - Women and Gender Studies: Event coming up this month.
 - Transfer Students Association: Thursday meetings are in person.
 - COBALT: Club participation is going down. Meetings are alternating Thursdays 1-2 p.m.
 - Student Veteran Organization: meetings are on the 1st and 4th Wednesdays, time varies. The club hopes to bridge the gap between student veterans and traditional students.
 - **Fashion Club**: Schedules changed to twice a month and are currently brainstorming more fun involvement.
 - **SNAP**: Nurses with the blood drive. Exclusive club meetings are on the 1st Monday of each month. Speaker coming in soon to talk about postgraduation employment opportunities. Nurses will wear orange as symbolism.
 - **Chemistry Club**: Meetings are every other Thursday, 6-7 p.m. Biomedical Engineer guest speaker will be coming in soon. Expecting more fun things.
 - LDSSA: Wednesday meetings weekly. The club wants to make small mementos, like keychains, but the meeting was pushed back due to the weather.
 - International Student Association: Hold meetings once a month to meet each other and play video games.
 - **K-Pop Dance**: Meet 2-3 times a week and recently uploaded dance video on YouTube channel.
 - Anime and Manga: Meeting strictly on discord for a while, had about 1-2 hangouts possibly.
