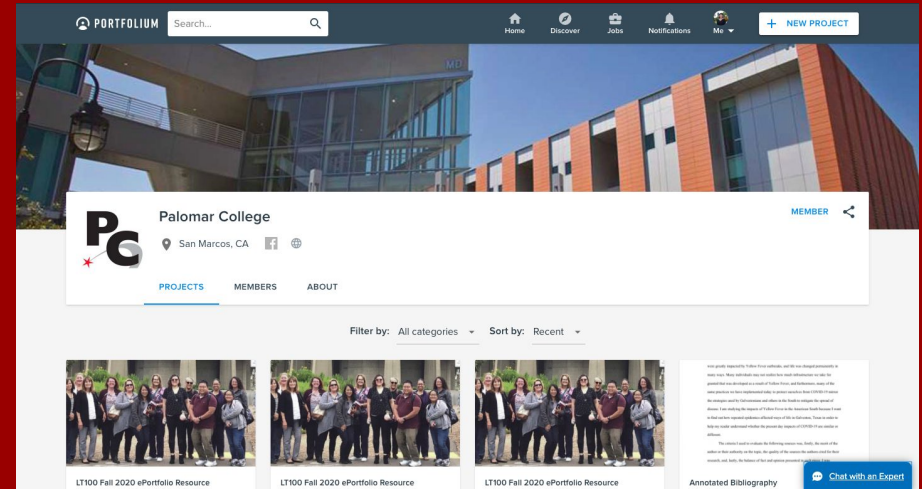
Purpose

What is it?

The Imposter Syndrome... What is it?

- According to CalTech, it can also be defined as “a collection of feelings of inadequacy that persist even in the face of information that indicates that the opposite is true. It is experienced internally as chronic self-doubt, and feelings of intellectual fraudulence.”
- Originally called *impostor phenomenon*, *impostor syndrome*, as it's now usually called, is commonly understood as a false and sometimes crippling belief that one's successes are the product of luck or fraud rather than skill.

The Imposter Syndrome... Who Gets It?

- A variety of individuals undergo bouts of imposter syndrome
 - Teachers, actors, academia
 - Students as well!
- Students are at a point in their lives where they are at a crossroads - where support from those they look up to is needed and appreciated
- Common in people who are in disenfranchised social groups:
 - Women, minority groups, first generation

How Portfolium Fits in the Picture

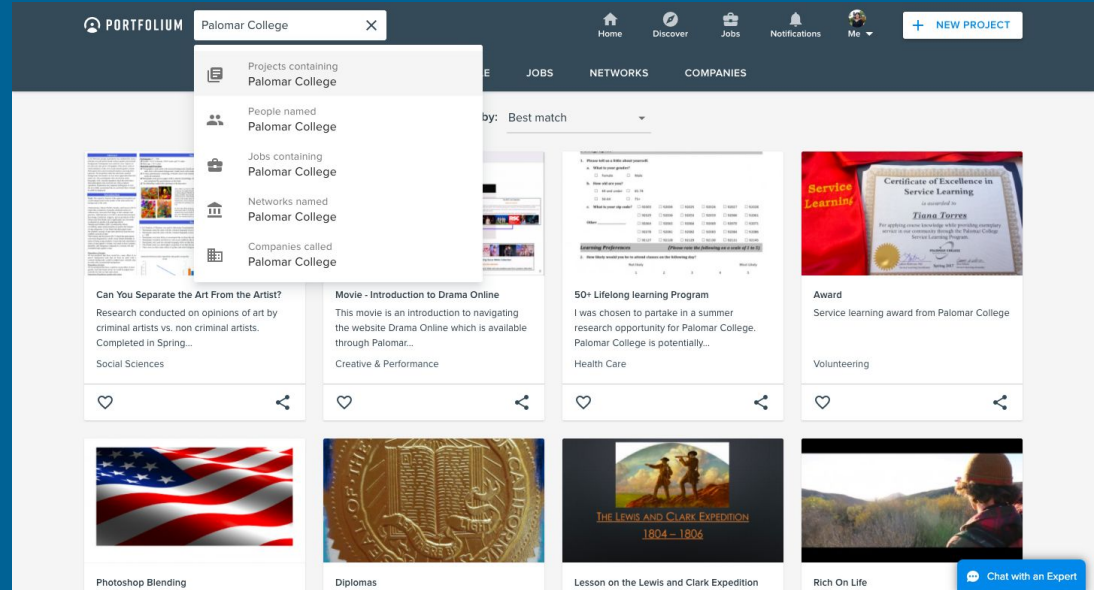
- Allows for a better understanding that each student is not just “another imposter”

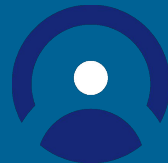

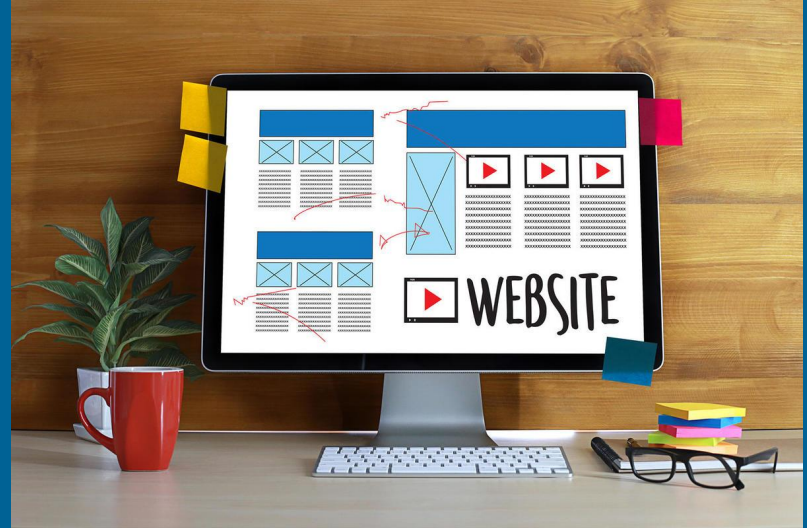

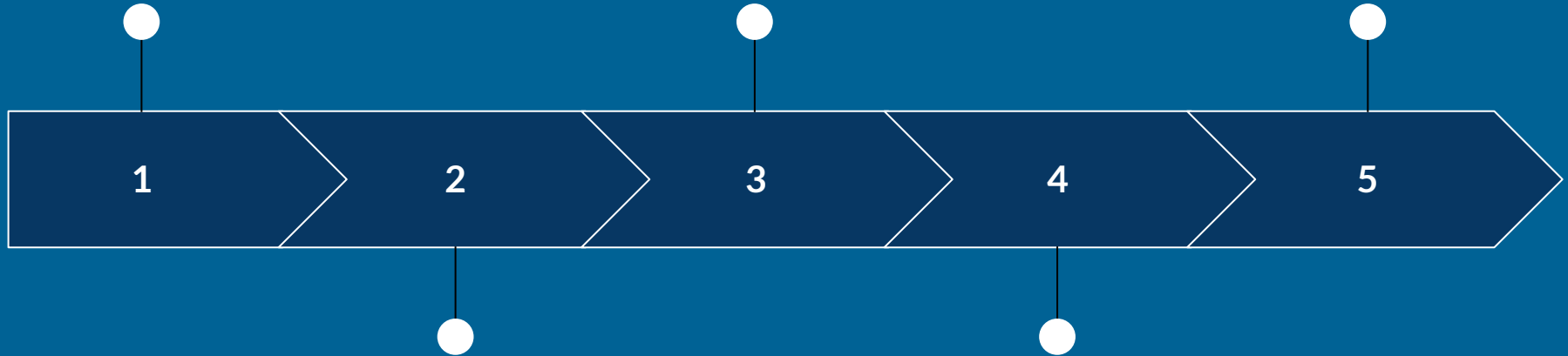

Portfolio: A How-To

— Setting up your account

 **PORTFOLIUM** A STEP BY STEP GUIDE

ON HOW TO MAKE YOUR VERY OWN ACCOUNT

-  **1** Log onto Canvas by using your school email and password 
-  **2** Go the left-hand side dashboard and click where it says **Account**
-  **3** Then proceed and click **Folio** 
-  **4** Click **Import from Canvas**
-  **5** Continue to create an account using your Palomar email 
-  **6** Once your account has been created, click **Canvas** and click **Continue**
-  **7** Once finished, go to the top and click **Me** 
-  **8** Then click **Settings**, and click **Email**
-  **9** You can then add in your personal email as a secondary email for your account, which will allow you to keep your account for the future

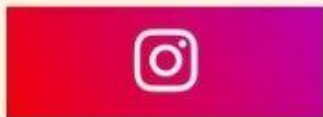
