2	I am starting to get it, but I had at least one major gap or error.	<b>Not Met but Demonstrates Some Learning:</b> Some relevant work, but with a fundamental error or misunderstanding. Work that shows promise but is incomplete.
1	My work shows a clear lack of understanding, or I skipped this part of the assessment.	<b>Not Met:</b> Not enough work to determine mastery, unclear and/or inconsistent work, or student participated in assessment but did not submit work pertaining to the specified skill.
0	I did not participate in any part of the assessment.	<b>No Participation:</b> Student was absent, did not participate in any part of the assessment, or no longer participating in the course.
