## WHO QUALIFIES FOR TRIO SSS

- ★ Must be a first-generation student, lowincome, or registered with the Palomar Disability Resource Center.
  - ★ Enrolled in 12 units or more unless you are a part of the Disability Resource Center at Palomar College. (9 units)
  - ★ Demonstrate academic need as determined by the TRIO SSS program director.
  - \* Must have the desire to earn a certificate, associates degree, or transfer to a 4-year university.

## HOW TO APPLY

1. Complete the student interest form.

- You will be contacted by a TRIO SSS staff member with an update. Applications will be sent to students who meet the program's eligibility requirements.

  - 4. Your application will be under review. (Note: the screening process can take up to 10 to 15 business days after the application has been submitted)
  - 5. After the application has been reviewed, you will be contacted by a staff member with the final update.
