PROGRAM UPDATES



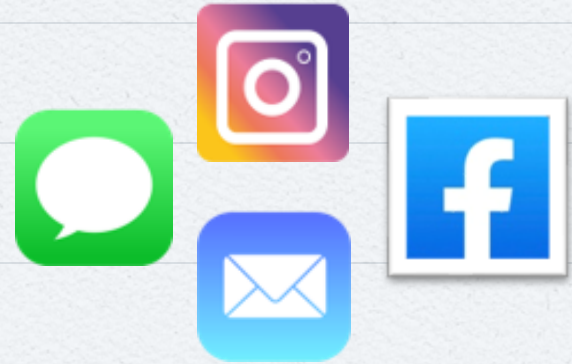
Palomar College will be operating remotely and In-person for the Fall 2022 semester.

Students are encouraged to meet with their advisor at least ONCE per month. Advising sessions will ensure your students stays on track to graduate and attend a post-secondary institution

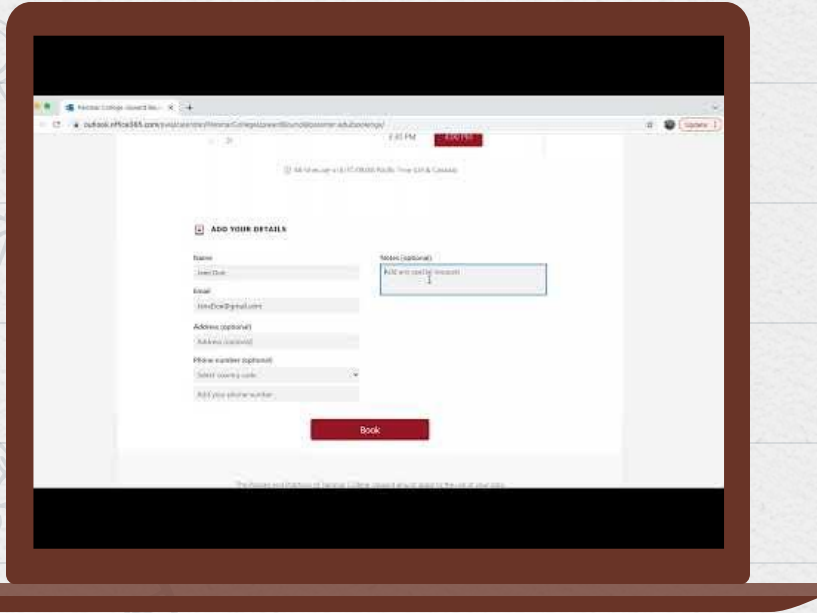
- X Appointments must be made via Bookings Link. On-line and In-person sessions are available.

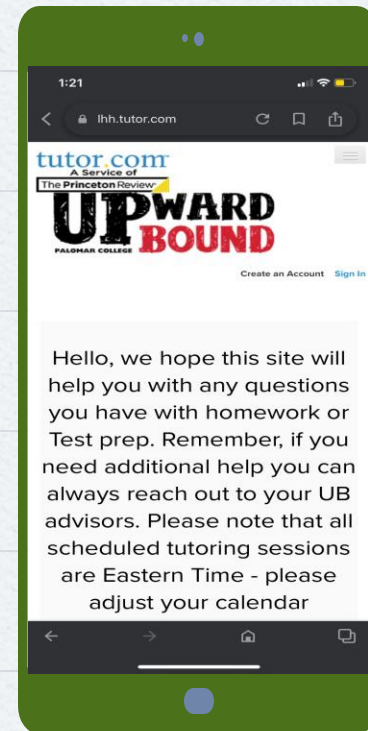
