Eligibility Information

Estimated Expected Family Contribution (EFC)= 001056

The EFC is a measure of how much you can contribute to the cost of your education. Schools use your EFC to determine your federal student aid eligibility.

The EFC is not how much aid you will receive or how much you have to pay for college. Based on the eligibility criteria you may be eligible for the following:

Pell Grant Estimate - \$4,120.00 Direct Stafford Loan Estimate - \$4,700.00

You may also be eligible to receive other federal, state, or institutional grants, scholarships, and/or work-study.

In addition, you should learn about federal tax benefits for education http://www.studentaid.ed.gov/types/tax-benefits, including the American Opportunity Tax Credit (AOTC).

Deadlines: CSU/UC Applications- Nov 30th

Early Decision Common App- Nov 1st

FAFSA- March 2nd (the earlier the better!)
