- **Skills:** *Plan, direct, or coordinate the operations of public or private sector organizations. Duties and responsibilities include formulating policies, managing daily operations, and planning the use of materials and human resources.*
- **Sample of reported job titles:** *Business Manager, Facilities Manager, General Manager (GM), Operations Director, Operations Manager, Plant Manager, Plant Superintendent, Production Manager, Store Manager*

To complete the MIL Apprenticeship Program and obtain this certificate, students will assess how the MIL Program Learning Outcomes have enhanced their overall job performance in the Marine Corps and submit their hours of OJT to Palomar College.
